WAS ALSO WANTED IN A MURDER CASE IN SONIPAT

Gang member involved in West Delhi showroom shooting killed in 'encounter'

A MEMBER of the Himanshu Bhatt gang who was allegedly involved in a shootout at a car showroom in West Delhi's Tilak Nagar was killed in an encounter in Rohini, police said.

Police identified the deceased as Ajay Singroha alias Goli. The operation, police said, was conducted by the Counter-Intelligence Unit (CIU) of the Delhi Police in Sector 29, Rohini. Singroha, police said, was wanted in a murder case in Murthal, in Haryana's Sonapat, from earlier this year. The sleuths of Delhi Police started to trace him only after his name emerged in the Tilak Nagar shootout. Police said Singroha was a close aide and trusted operative of Bhatt.

Police said they received a tip-off that Singroha was to arrive at the Khera Khurd area. An ambush was laid and once he was spotted in a Honda City car, police said, he was asked to surrender. But he allegedly opened fire at the policemen and tried to escape. He was killed when police retaliated.

Singroha was wanted in four cases in Delhi and Haryana on several charges, including assault, and under the Arms Act, police said. He has nine cases registered against him in Murthal, Haryana, police said.

According to an official press release by the Delhi Police, "The investigation utilised a combination of technical and manual surveillance. Technical analysis indicated that the suspect (Singroha) skillfully used technology to evade detection, avoiding personal communication devices and complicating tracking efforts. Concurrently, field teams and informants were deployed to gather comprehensive intelligence on his whereabouts."

On May 16, a tip-off revealed Singroha's movement in Rotoli village in Rohtak. Acting on this information, the Special Cell set up a strategic trap and intercepted his vehicle, said the release. Upon confrontation, Singroha opened fire at the police, prompting a brief exchange of gunfire by the Special Cell team, during which Singroha was injured.

He was immediately transported to BSA Hospital in Rohini by a PCR van, where he was declared brought dead.

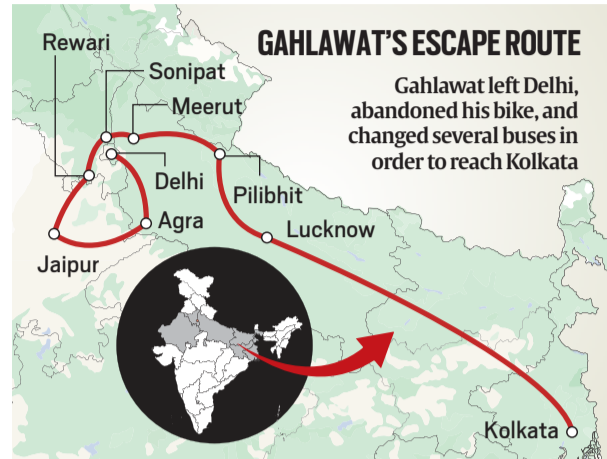
AFTER HE allegedly opened fire at a car showroom in Tilak Nagar on May 6, Mohit Ridhaan Gahlawat gave police the slip. For the next six days, he hopped from city to city — changing trains and buses — to head to Kolkata. Just as he was "hours away from crossing the border to Bangladesh", and then fleeing to the US his escape plan was cut short by Delhi Police who arrested him on May 12.

Police also arrested another shooter, Abhishek alias Churan, on May 10.

Gahlawat, an officer said, was waiting for other gang members who were going to smuggle him out of the country. "Once in Bangladesh, they were going to take him through what is called the 'Donkey route' or Dunki (an illegal passage to enter a foreign country) and try and smuggle him to California," the officer said.

Gahlawat, police said, had opened fire using a country-made pistol at the showroom, Fusion Cars, on May 6. BJP functionary Vikas Tyagi and six others who were inside the showroom sustained injuries.

Soon after the shooting, police said, "Gangster Himanshu Bhatt, who is part of the Neeraj Bawana-Rahul Bali-Devendra Bambha gang and operates the syndicate from Portugal, made an extortion call to the showroom owner. He



demanding Rs 5 crore." Gahlawat, police said, had also left a note, mentioning the names of his gang leaders including jailed gangsters Bali and Bawana, with the showroom's security guard. Police later questioned Bali and Bawana at Tihar jail regarding the shootout. On May 8, the northern range of the Delhi Police's Special Cell had also arrested a man, Ketan, claiming he provided logistic support to the shooters.

Meanwhile, the Crime Branch's New Delhi Range, led by ACP Umesh Barthwal, and Delhi Police's Anti-Rowdy Unit were assigned the case. Around 25 sleuths were part of the operation.

Teams scanned CCTV footage at the spot which showed Gahlawat and Churan heading out of the showroom and then opening fire. Footage also showed Gahlawat and Abhishek leaving the spot separately on two bikes parked nearby. Abhishek left the spot with Ketan, the officer said.

A Crime Branch officer said that while Gahlawat's face was not clearly visible in the footage, his mobile phone location was used as the primary tool to trace him. "Besides we activated all our informers to help us trace his

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hideout," he said.

How did he flee? A police officer explained his escape route: "After the firing, Gahlawat drove to Agra on a two-wheeler and then to Jaipur where he dropped off his accomplice. He also left the bike there. He took a bus to Rewari and then hitched a ride in a tempo to his village in Sonapat."

"At Sonapat, he changed his clothes and took a taxi to Meerut and then to Pilibhit. Once he reached Lucknow, he boarded a bus and reached Kolkata. He was very careful and changed buses to avoid detection," the officer said. Police finally arrested Gahlawat from Babu Ghat in West Bengal on Sunday evening.

The showroom firing, police said, was his first crime in Delhi.

"During questioning, he said that gang leader Bhatt asked him to stay away from Haryana and head towards West Bengal where he (Bhatt) had made arrangements to smuggle him (Gahlawat) out of the country," the police officer said.

Boy denied treatment for lack of cotton at govt hospitals: HC takes note

THE DELHI High Court Friday sought the Delhi government's stand on a plea highlighting the denial of medical treatment to a minor boy at government-run hospitals for want of cotton swabs and non-availability of doctors.

A single-judge bench of Justice Subramonium Prasad issued notice to the Delhi government, directing it to file a status report in 10 days. The HC directed that the report should also "indicate the condition" of other Delhi government-run hospitals. The matter is next listed on May 30.

On April 1, the petitioner, a Class III student, fell while playing at his school and fractured his left arm. He was rushed to the emergency ward of Dr Hedgewar Aarogya Sansthan where the doctors referred him to a higher centre.

The plea states that the doctor on duty wrote "Cotton NA" on the boy's emergency card and the boy was advised to buy the same.

The boy's father, who works as a security guard, took him to Chacha Nehru Bal Chikitsalaya, where they were told that "no doctor was available as it was

already 5.30 pm" and doctors had "left the hospital at 3 pm". Having no other option of treatment in a government hospital, the petitioner approached a private clinic, which then referred him to Chandra Laxmi Hospital. Around 12.30 am, a plaster was eventually placed on his left arm.

"The mother of the petitioner is working as a maid and she borrowed Rs 12,000 from her employer and paid the bill of Chandra Laxmi Hospital," the plea filed by advocates Ashok Agarwal and Kumar Utkarsh states.

Against the denial of treatment at the government hospitals, the petitioner, through his advocate, also served the Delhi government a legal notice on April 6, demanding reimbursement of his medical expenses along with a compensation of Rs 1 lakh.

However, no response has been received so far.

Flight bound to Bengaluru grounded after fire

AN AIR India flight, bound to Bengaluru from Delhi, was grounded around 20 minutes after take-off after an air-conditioning unit in the aircraft caught fire on Friday. A full emergency was declared and the flight landed back in Delhi, said officials.

Flight AI807, with 175 passengers on board, took off from Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport at 5.20 pm. The AC unit caught fire while the flight was mid-air, following which the Air Traffic Control declared a full emergency at 5.52 pm. The flight landed back at Delhi airport at 6.38 pm and the fire was doused by three fire tenders. No casualty was reported.

"Air India flight AI807 flying Delhi to Bengaluru returned to Delhi this evening after a fire warning from its auxiliary power unit. After the pilots exercised necessary protocols, the aircraft made an uneventful landing and all passengers and crew deplaned at the aerobridge safely," said an Air India spokesperson. "Our colleagues on ground have made alternative arrangements for guests to proceed back to their destination at the earliest," the spokesperson added.
