Make all sewage treatment plants fit in four weeks, NGT tells UP

THE NATIONAL Green Tribunal (NGT) has directed the Uttar Pradesh chief secretary to disclose the steps to be taken for making non-functional sewage treatment plants (STPs) functional and to ensure that all STPs comply with specified norms, within four weeks.

The bench emphasised the need for immediate action to address the sewage management issues across multiple districts of Uttar Pradesh along the course of Ganga river and its tributaries.

"The state must disclose the timeline for tapping these drains and for setting up the STPs for treating the sewage from these drains. Hence, we require the Chief Secretary, State of UP to file the affidavit disclosing the information relating to each of the drains in different districts, sewage generated from it, the STP to which it is proposed to be connected, the timeline for making the STP functional, funds which are available, identification and allotment of land for setting up the STP," directed the threemember board. The NGT has scheduled the next hearing for January 20, 2025.

The intervention comes in the wake of a compliance report filed by the UP government on October 30, detailing the current status of sewage treatment and the discharge of untreated wastewater into the river. The report highlighted gaps in sewage treatment infrastructure, especially in key districts of Prayagraj, Kanpur Dehat and Ayodhya.

"...we found that within the Prayagraj Nagar Nigam, 468.28 MLD sewage is generated, the quantity of sewage treated is 394.48 MLD and the existing treatment... capacity of STPs is only 340 MLD. Therefore, the gap in sewage generation and existing capacity is 128.28 MLD. The report further reflects that in Prayagraj, untreated sewage from 25 untapped drains is discharged into Ganga and from 15 untapped drains in Yamuna," read the order.

Man arrested for killing mother after row over marriage: Police

HIMANSHU HARSH NEW DELHI, NOVEMBER 9

A 31-YEAR-OLD man was arrested on Thursday from Delhi's Badarpur for allegedly stabbing to death his mother following an

argument over marriage and his

desire to move to Canada. Deputy Commissioner of Police (Southeast Delhi) Ravi Kumar Singh said the victim, Geeta (50), was brought dead

with multiple stab wounds to Apollo Hospital on November 6. During investigation, police learnt that around 3.30 pm the

same day, accused Krishan Kant alias Rohin called his father, Surjeet Singh Choudhary (52), a property dealer, to his Jaitpur office and asked him to return to their house in Molarband.

"Upon arrival, Kant apologised to his father and asked him to go upstairs. He ran out of the house after that. When Surieet went to the first floor, he found Geeta lying lifeless in a pool of blood with multiple injuries over her body. He rushed her to the hospital with the help of neighbours, but she was declared dead on arrival," Singh said. Kant was arrested the next day.

revealed that a heated argument broke out between him and his mother over his desire to migrate to Canada for a job. "The family reportedly wanted him to marry first. In a fit of rage, he allegedly used a knife to attack his mother," the officer said.

All citizens of Delhi who have already attained the age of 18 years or attaining the age of 18 years as on 01.01.2025 can apply in Form-6 at these SPECIAL CAMPS.

Any eligible citizen, who is going to attain the age of 18 years on or before any of the subsequent qualifying dates in the year 2025, that is to say, the 1st April 2025, 1st July 2025 or 1st October 2025, may also file his or her claim for inclusion of name in the roll, in Form-6, in advance. Such advance forms shall however, be disposed of in the first month of respective quarter only.

APPEAL

- 1. All new applicants attaining the age of 18 years by 01.10.2025, please apply in Form-6.
- 2. Apply for correction/replacement of EPIC/Shifting/Marking of PwD through Form-8
- 3. Never have name in the electoral roll in more than one constituency or in any constituency more than once. It is a punishable offence u/s 17 & 18 of the Representation of People Act, 1950. Apply for deletion of multiple entry(ies) in Form-7.
- 4. Application can be made online at ECI's Voters' Portal https://voters.eci.gov.in or Voter Helpline App /Saksham App (Divyangjan)
- 5. Download prescribed Form from these Websites or Obtain from the Voter Centre and submit at Voter Centre of your Assembly Constituency or your Polling Station Location whose list is available on www.ceodelhi.gov.in
- 6. General Public is also informed that mere holding of Voter Identity card does not entitle the voter to cast his/her vote during election. The name of the voter has to be present in the updated electoral roll. Accordingly, every voter is earnestly requested to check his/her name in the draft electoral roll by any of the following modes:-

46/2018 in the matter of N Jayasimha Vs Govt of NCT of Delhi, CPCB has framed "Guidelines for Environmental **Management of Dairy Farms and**

Gaushalas". The guidelines framed by CPCB are available at the website of DPCC i.e. on <u>dpcc.delhiqovt.nic.in</u>

Subsequent to the guidelines, the Dairy Farms & Gaushalas have been categorized as Orange and Green Category respectively based on the directions given by CPCB under Section 18(1)(b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 on 10.07.2020. The categorization is available on the DPCC site

In compliance of the orders of Hon'ble High Court in the case in O.A. No. 13236/2022 in the matter of Sunayana Sibal Vs GNCTD, all gaushalas, the stand alone dairy farms having 15 or above cattle and all the dairies operating in dairy colonies in Delhi (irrespective of the number of cattle), which are registered with MCD, are hereby directed to immediately apply on-line for Consent under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act,1981, as per relevant category, in DPCC within 15 days from issue of this notice failing which further necessary action under relevant acts shall be initiated.
