SC: Governor can't doubt Punjab session validity, must decide on Bills

Also issues notice to Tamil Nadu Gov, says withholding Bills 'matter of serious concern'

THE SUPREME Court on Friday said that any attempt to cast doubt on the session of the legislature would be fraught with great perils to democracy, as it rejected Punjab Governor Banwarilal Purohit's contention that the state Vidhan Sabha session held on June 19 - 20, 2023 was not constitutionally valid and asked him to "proceed to take a decision on the Bills which have been submitted for assent on the basis that the sitting...was constitutionally valid".

"There is no valid constitutional basis to cast doubt on the validity of the session of the vidhan sabha held on June 19 and June 20, 2023. Any attempt to cast doubt on the session of the legislature would be fraught with great perils to democracy. The speaker... was acting well within his jurisdiction in adjourning the House sine die. The convening of the House on June 19 and 29, 2023, was within the ambit of Rule 16 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business of the Punjab Vidhan Sabha", a three-judge bench presided by Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud and comprising Justices J B

Pardiwala and Manoj Mishra said.

The order came on a plea by the Punjab government which said the state governor was sitting on Bills sent to him for assent for the legislative assembly.

The bench also issued notice on a Tamil Nadu government plea accusing the state governor of withholding consent to Bills presented by the state legislature. "The issues raise a matter of serious concern. From the tabulated statement, it appears that as many as 12 Bills which have been submitted to the governor under Art 200 have not elicited further action. Other matters such as proposals of grant of sanction, premature release of prisoners, appointments are pending," the bench said.

Ruling on the Punjab petition, the bench said, "Casting doubt on the validity of the session of the House is not a constitutional option open to the Governor. The legislative assembly consists of duly elected members of the legislature. During the tenure of the Assembly, the House is governed by the decisions which are taken by the speaker in matters of adjournment and prorogation."

"We are therefore of the view that the Governor of Punjab must now proceed to take a decision

on the Bills which have been submitted for assent on the basis that the sitting of the House which was conducted on June 19 and 20, 2023, was constitutionally valid", the court said.

The court pointed out that "Rule 16 of the Rules of Procedure governing the Punjab Vidhan Sabha, empowers it to adjourn from time to time by its own order. The first proviso to Rule 16 acknowledges that adjournment of the Vidhan Sabha may be to a particular day or sine die. However, even when an adjournment takes place sine die, the speaker is entrusted in public interest to call a meeting of the Vidhan Sabha before the date to which it has been adjourned. In other words, these provisions are a clear indicator in regard to the control of the Speaker in the conduct both of the legislative business of the House and in matters pertaining to its adjournment".

Earlier, the bench said the legislative assembly was within its rights to adjourn the session sine die and reconvene it because the budget session hadn't ended.

The court told the Governor

"you are playing with fire" and asked "how can you say that a bill which has been passed cannot be assented to because session is invalid?...You realise the gravity of what you are doing?...Tell us the power of the governor to say this? The speaker has no power to say adjourn sine die?".

The court added, "...these are bills passed by elected members...Will we continue to be a parliamentary democracy?...Please don't deflect the course of bills passed by duly elected assembly. It's a matter of very serious concern. This is a very serious matter."

Appearing for the state government, Senior Advocate A M Singhvi took the bench through the rules of procedure of the assembly and said "the governor has no locus standi. The adjournment sine die has to be done with consultation with speaker".

Pointing out the issue of Governors withholding assent to Bills was happening in many states, Singhvi told the bench that "a message has to be sent. They cannot hold back". Though Solicitor General Tushar Mehta tried to diffuse the situation stating a solution can be found in a week's time, the court went on to pronounce the order.

The SG urged the bench to record in the order whether it is valid to keep an assembly forever in suspended animation without proroguing it.

SC refuses to stay proceedings in suits linked to Mathura-Shahi Idgah dispute

New Delhi: The Supreme Court Friday refused to stay the proceedings before the Allahabad High Court on suits related to the Sri Krishna Janmabhoomi-Shahi Idgah dispute, saying it will not be fair to interfere with the high court order without hearing both

the sides.

The apex court was hearing a petition challenging a HC order which had transferred to itself all matters related to the dispute pending before a Mathura court.

The plea filed by the Committee of Management Trust

Shahi Masjid Idgah challenging the May 26 order of the high court came up for hearing before a bench headed by Justice Sanjay Kishan Kaul. The counsel appearing for the petitioner urged the bench to stay the ongoing proceedings before the high court.

"Without hearing both the sides, it will not be fair to interfere with the high court order," the bench said. The apex court noted altogether 18 petitions were pending before the high court in the matter. It posted the matter for hearing on January 9. PTI

\$3 mn found by garbage collector confirmed fake; employer tortured by gang for currency

THE CURRENCY notes worth \$3 million found by a ragpicker near a railway track in Bengaluru and handed over to the authorities were found to be fake.

A senior police officer confirmed to *The Indian Express* that HDFC Bank, the nodal bank appointed by the RBI to check the notes, found them to be fake. It reported that the notes were either "printed or photocopied". Following the report, the Hebbal police filed an FIR under IPC Section 489A (counterfeiting currency notes) against unknown people.

On November 3, Saleman SK, a native of West Bengal's Nadia district, found 23 bundles of US dollars wrapped in paper near the Nagawara railway station. On Sunday, he approached social activist and national executive member of Swaraj India, R Kalem Ullah, and they handed over the currency notes to the Hebbal police after meeting Bengaluru city police commissioner B Dayananda.

Though Saleman was relieved after handing over the notes to the police, Touhidul Islam alias Bappa, 33, a scrap dealer under whom Saleman worked, was kidnapped on November 7 by around 5 men for the currency notes.

Kaleem Ullah said, "Two men barged in and asked him about the US currency. When he told them it was handed over to the police, they did not believe and took him away."

The assailants allegedly tortured Bappa before dumping him near Manyata tech park the same day. However, Bappa chose not to file a complaint. "If I tell their names, my life will be in danger," Bappa said in a purported video message.

POLLUTION

Increase surveillance, awareness: Centre to Delhi, neighbouring states

SURVEILLANCE OF air pollution-related illnesses, building a health workforce, and creating awareness of the ill effects of pollution are among the measures suggested by the Director General of Health Services to Delhi, Haryana, Punjab, Rajasthan, and Uttar Pradesh for dealing with the high pollution levels this time of the year.

Written last week, the letter advised measures that people could take to reduce their exposure, such as checking air quality indices before stepping out, avoiding routes with heavy vehicular congestion, and using cleaner cooking fuels.

"Vulnerable people should seek medical help when they first develop worsening of their illness or feel discomfort and symptoms due to poor air quality," the letter

said. The letter also asked the states to increase awareness to curb stubble and waste burning, avoid firecrackers during festivities, and increase the use of public transport instead of personal vehicles.

Last month, Union Health Secretary Sudhanshu Pant had written to all states urging them to develop state and city-level ac-

tion plans for climate change and to expand a network of sentinel hospitals that can keep track of pollution-related cases throughout the year. A similar sentinel network exists for illnesses such as flu and Covid-19.

The latest advisory by the health ministry focuses on the health of school-going children, suggesting various measures.
