### **Project at a Glance:-**

Education is a fundamental right of every citizen granted by the Article 21 A of the Constitution. This has got a perfect shape in the form of Right to Education Act 2009. Education plays a very important role in shaping the future of a country. Assuming the responsibility of providing education to the children belong in to nearby villages, Project affected area, THDCIL as its Corporate Social Responsibility is running a school at Koteshwar Project site since 2014 with the help of private institutions.

### **Implementation:-**

There was an agreement in force till the academic year 2014 under which the Drona International School, Dehradun was given the task of running the school. After the expiry of the agreement with Drona International School, Dehradun, a new agency i.e. Omkaranand Saraswati Public School, Education Society, Dev Prayag was assigned the task of running, managing and administering the school in Koteshwar initially for a period of one year till the new society is registered.

New society was registered and named as **Swami Omkarananda Saraswati Public School Samiti Koteshwar**. In the year 2014-15, the school was run by the Omkaranand Saraswati Public School, Education Society, Dev Prayag and then onwards a new society registered, was managing the school with the new name of the school "**Swami Omkarananda Saraswati Public School Koteshwar**".

### **Facilities Provided:-**

This newly registered society is now taking care of all day to day activities of the school. The school at present pursues the CBSE pattern of education and has applied for its recognition from the state government. The session started with 8 Teachers and 128 students studying in the school from Nursery class to Class VIII.

These students were guided by a team of qualified teaching staff and supporting staff headed by the Principal.

THDCIL has provided necessary infrastructure to run the school free of cost. which includes class rooms equipped with furniture, Computer, stationeries, chalks, photocopier, library, telephone etc and other basic amenities includes safe and clean

drinking water, toilet facilities and play ground. The school staff is provided accommodation at nominal rate by THDCIL. A school bus has been arranged by THDCIL for commuting students from their villages to school and back. Books are being provided free of cost by SEWA-THDC.

02 numbers of Computers along with UPS was provided to cater the needs of students of senior class studying computers. The school had an old and lower capacity Water purifier which was replaced with the new larger capacity purifier and cooler. As the number of students is increasing every year the demand for furniture for staff as well as for students was raising and looking into the needs 15 chairs, 20 sets of Desk-Bench, 01 Almirah and 3 White Boards were provided. For the morning school assembly 02 numbers of Dais and a set of Band & Sound System were provided. The library of school was upgraded with furniture and books. 01 Harmonium and 01 Dholak. With these facilities the school started organizing Baal Sabhas every week which is aimed at honing the extracurricular skills of children.

The Parents Teachers Association ( PTA) was constituted with selected members from the villages and Sh. Vikram Rudhia was elected president of the PTA. After constituting PTA meeting were carried out to reduce the problems faced while smoothly running the school. It was the result of these meetings that the number of complaints drastically reduced. The Flag hoisting ceremony was held for the first time on Independence Day with the erection of Flag post in the school. Two new classrooms were constructed on first floor in order to resolve the issue of rooms as the number of students is increasing every year. During rainy season the school play cum prayer ground could not be used for anything but due to efforts of management concreting of the School Prayer cum Play Ground was completed and issue was resolved

A visit to KHEP Power House for the students of class VI, VII and VIII was organized so as to enhance their knowledge about hydro project.

30 students were distributed Uniforms, School Bags, Shoes, Note Books and other such items under CSR activity. Many students of the school cleared the entrance test of various schools so as to continue the studies further after VIII class. Prize

Distribution ceremony for meritorious students was organized where the winners were awarded by the Head of the project.

Various activities like painting and essay competition, celebration of children day , Independence day , Republic day were organized and the performers were awarded. Cleanliness drive was started so as to spread awareness among the children with an intention that they may extend the drive among their villages.

### **Benefits from the Project:-**

The school is providing quality education to the students of the nearby area and most of the students belong to economically weaker section of society. The fee charged per month amounts to Rs. 300.00 per student and economic weaker section (BPL) students are given education free of cost. The financial gap between the fee collected from the students and financial implication on account of salary to the staff and other miscellaneous expenditure is being borne by SEWA-THDC Rishikesh.

From time to time on various occasions in order to encourage students to develop their extra as well as co-curricular skills THDCIL organizes various competition and the participation from the students is encouraging. Students also participate regularly on all the national festival and functions organized by THDCIL.

Students are provided dress for participating in various day to day functions organized by THDCIL. From time to time surprise inspections by Koteshwar Management are carried out in order to check the quality of education being provided to students. Continuous efforts are being put to improve the quality of education and turn this school into an institution of standard class prevalent in the state. The Koteshwar Hydro Project Management is committed towards leaving no stone unturned in ensuring that the children in the nearby villages get what they deserve. Being a Mini Ratna Company THDCIL views, providing education as a great responsibility and has been trying to ensure the same with the help of SEWA-THDC.
