Project at a Glance :-The Aim of SEWA-THDC is committed to improve the health status and quality of life of peoples, by focusing on health issues with the objective of reducing disease burden, creating an enabling environment, influencing direct and indirect health determinants such as nutrition, water, sanitation and other factors like education and employment in the state. The primary health center intends to reach the replacement level of fertility, population stability with due attention to disadvantaged sections, inaccessible and remote areas.

The Basic Health Centre that is being run under SEWA THDC along with SBSE College, University of Delhi is providing modern medical facilities to the villagers that too without any charges. Nearly 85 villages around the region are benefitting from this PHC. The facilities such as path labs, Ambulance service, X-ray is available in this center. In the year 2020-21 around 3,133 villagers have benefitted out of this PHC. This is a very big leap in progress as villagers had to travel far off distances for treatments and the cost of travelling as well as treatment used to be very high. Service to mankind is indeed service to GOD.
