Project at a Glance

A deaf school is running at IIT Campus, Roorkee since, 11.11.1989 as a social initiative of Indian Institute of Technology, Roorkee. Main objective has been to impart special education to the handicapped deaf children on modern and scientific lines. From humble beginning about 20 years ago, the school has grown into a full fledged 10+2 school for the education of Deaf Children. Its students appear in NIOS Board examinations.

Along with normal education, the school students are also given Vocational Training in about 7 different areas. The ultimate aim of the school is to make every child self-dependent in life having learnt all independent Living Skills before he/she leaves the portal of the school. After passing 10+2 examination, most of our students are employed in Bank, Post Office, Titan Watch Company, Kevin Power solution and some of them are also self employed.

The school takes help of IIT Roorkee/ faculty to undertake research on the development of latest technologies to develop assistive devices and other educational teaching aids, various software, teaching learning materials and appliances to help educate and train deaf children.

School Management Committee (SMC) of Roorkee School for the Deaf (RSD) requested to SEWA-THDC for financial assistance in construction of class rooms/hall. SMC of RSD submitted a proposal for ₹ 1.20 crore for construction of 02 Nos. hall and 02 Nos. parents waiting rooms. SEWA-THDC committee sanctioned ₹ 40.00 Lac for SEWA-THDC wing in RSD. The said wing has been constructed, photographs are enclosed.

Benefit from the Project

As per details given by principal RSD, at present 87 children are getting education in Roorkee School for the Deaf and they are coming from a radius of 80 Km. After construction of the SEWA-THDC wing (hall) in Roorkee school for the Deaf, the management committee of RSD, school children and their parents are now happy and are benefited on daily basis.
