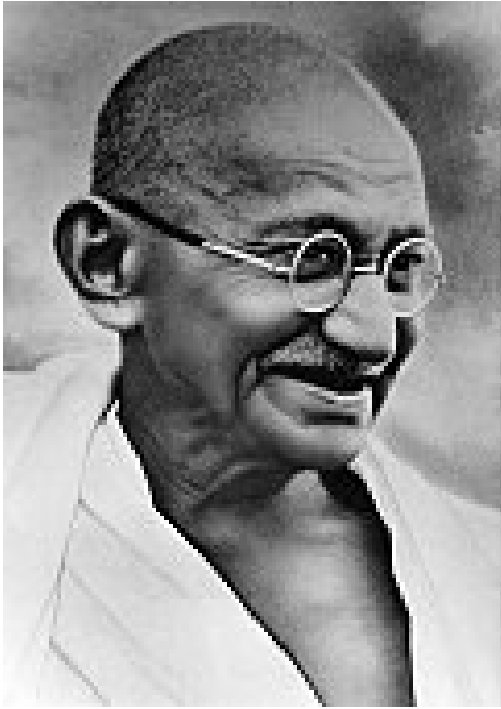

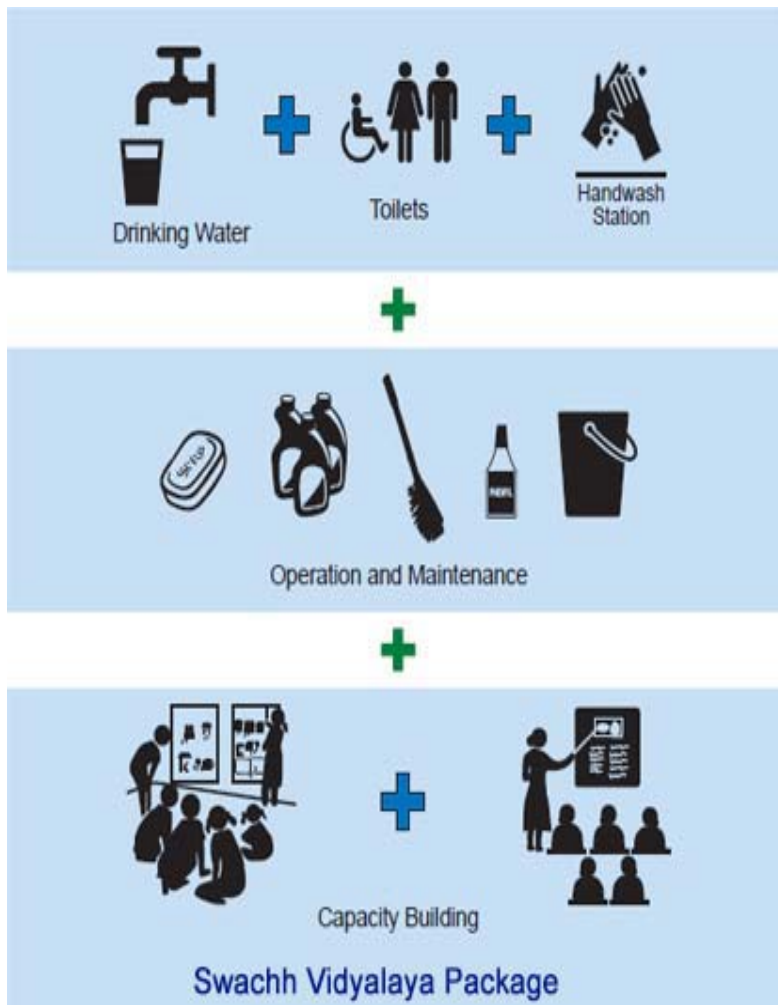

The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India launched 'Swachh Bharat Swachh Vidyalaya' (SBSV) initiative in 2014 to ensure that all schools in India have access to separate functional toilets for boys and girls. The initiative also has its emphasis on promoting safe and appropriate hygiene practices in schools and behaviour among children.

Project at a Glance

Swachh Bharat: Swachh Vidyalaya is the national campaign driving 'Clean India: Clean School'. A key feature of the campaign is to ensure that every school in India has a set of functioning and well maintained water, sanitation and hygiene facilities. Water, sanitation and hygiene in schools refers to a combination of technical and human development components that necessary to produce a healthy school environment and to develop or support appropriate health and hygiene behaviours. The technical components including drinking water, hand washing, toilets and soap facilities in school compound for use by children and teachers. The human development components are the activities that promote conditions within the school and practices of children that help to prevent water, hygiene and sanitation related diseases.

For fulfil the above said mission, THDCIL adopted four schools nearby Rishikesh office campus.
