<u>Introduction</u>:- Ambulance is a health care service intended for the primary diagnosis and treatment of life-threatening illnesses, injuries or poisonings, and, if necessary, for the transport of people in need to a hospital. Ambulance operates round the clock and is intended to provide emergency medical care outside the premises of health care providers

Project at a Glance:- THDCIL is implementing CSR activities in its project affected area through SEWA-THDC. Under this program different CSR activities i.e Education, Health & sanitation, Rural Development, Environment and Livelihood generation are being implemented in the area. All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Rishikesh is an apex healthcare institute established by an Act of Parliament by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. In the 23th BBLC, the matter was discussed and it was agreed that Ambulance (Force Traveler Ambulance BS IV FM2.6 CR 3350 MM WB (13+D) HR, Power Steering can be provided to the AII India Institute of Medical Sciences AIIMS which shall be used to organize medical camps in project affected area Tehri and Rishikesh and provide facility to all project affected and deprived people. Time to Time medical team of AIIMS will visit the project site and provide medical facilities with distribution of free medicines. On 18/12/2018 respected CMD(THDCIL) and Director (AIIMS) jointly flag off the equipped ambulance in presence of senior officers of THDC & AIIMS at premises of AIIMS Rishikesh. Keys of the Ambulance was handed over to AIIMS for patient care service & medical camps.

Implementing Agency:- SEWA-THDC has implemented the work of procurement of ambulance and its modification. The ambulance was procured from Force Motors through Gem and necessary modification and installment of medical equipment have been carried out through M/S Alfa special purpose vehicle Pvt. Ltd. Palwal Hariyana.

Benefit from the project:- The Ambulance Van (Force) have been provided to All India Institute of Medical Science Rishikesh for transportation of project affected & underprivileged patients and organizing medical camps. This will provided facilities in emergency of situations and health camp organization.

In Journal project affected people rehabilitees of Tehri project and other deprived persons are being benefitted through ambulance. Ambulance services make a huge unmeasured contributions to patient.
