Project at a Glance:-

As per 2017 census still 66% (According to the World Bank) population of our Hindustan is residing in villages. Only Uttarakhand has a population of 10116752 in which 69.45% of the population residing in remote areas. A lot of villages where no medical and education facilities are available even water crisis. Due to a lack of medical facilities some of people are compelled to die without treatment and medicines. Road connectivity is too poor to arrive to the place where some medical facilities are available. The life of Uttarakhand – hills is very hard and tough. Sem Mukhem is also one of the extreme remote areas of Uttarakhand.

Looking at such a condition of Sem Mukhem Sewa THDC established a Homoeopathic Chartable Health Centre under the supervision of Swami Narayan Mission Society in July 2019.

Benefits from the Project:-

Sem-Mukhem and 21 other villages such as Kodar, Khurmula, Mukhmal Gaon, Dangi Gaon, Ghodpur Gaon, Gadvan Gaon, Aunal Gaon, Herwal Gaon, Deen Goan, Ghandiyal Gaon, Mukhem Gaon, Sadar Gaon, Raika Gaon, Mar Gaon, Pokhri and Dhangar Gaon, Kudiyal Gaon, Mastwadi Gaon, Khamkhal Gaon and Garman Gaon etc. all of the villages are in the most intense remote areas of the mountain (Uttarakhand), total population of these villages is approximately more than 50,000. Except tourists, so many people come out of these villages to visit God Nag Raja.

With a great contribution of SEWA- THDC especially in medical field thousands of people of Sem Mukhem had been getting benefits for 09 months. It was a very commendable effort of SEWA- THDC; it was like a boon of God for the patients of Sem Mukhemand (15 Grampanchayats) even tourists go to North Dwarika, Sem Nagraj (the fifth Dham of Uttarakhand). they would also get medical benefits.

From July 2019 to March 2020, around 13616 patients (a big populated 18 Gram Panchayats) of different cases and tourists also go to Sem Mukhem, (the fifth Dham of Uttarakhand) were checked up, treated and provided them medicines free of cost in the O.P.D. of Sem Mukhem.
