- 2. This invitation of Bid is has been issued in single stage two-part bid system (Part-1-PQ & Techno-commercial bid and Part-2- Price bid). Bid with relevant documents should be uploaded on the GeM Portal <a href="https://gem.gov.in">https://gem.gov.in</a> up to 15:00 Hrs. on scheduled date of submission. The Bids received after closing date and time will not be considered.
- **3.** A Consultant will be selected in accordance with Least Cost Selection methodology and procedures described in this Request for Proposal (RFP).
- **4.** The bidder/consultant should be the Class-I Local Supplier only. Presently, Class-I local supplier means a supplier or service provider whose goods, services or works offered for procurement has local content equal to or more than 60%, as per the MoP order dated 16.11.2021 and amendments thereof.
- 5. As per the Guidelines Govt. of India, for bidders registered as Micro & Small Enterprises in India, the payment of cost of bid documents and EMD (if any) will not be applicable. However, the proof for the same is to be submitted by the bidders for eligibility. In case MSE bidders are participating in the tendering process as a JV/Consortium partner/member, exemption of EMD will not be applicable.

Further, as per GeM's GTC, Sellers/ Service Provider having annual turnover of INR 500 Crore or more, at least in one of the past three completed financial years are exempted from submission of Bid Security (EMD).

- **6.** As this work is not splitable, for participating MSEs quoting price within price band of L1+15 % (percent) shall be allowed to execute the total package by bringing down their price to L1 price in a situation where L1 price is from someone other than a Micro and Small Enterprises (MSES).
- 7. Any 'Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India', as specified in the Bidding Documents, will be eligible to bid in this tender only, if bidder is registered with the Competent Authority as mentioned in the Bidding Documents.

Further, any bidder (including an Indian Bidder) having Specified Transfer of Technology (ToT) arrangement with an entity from a country which share a land border with India will be eligible to bid only, if the bidder is registered with the same Competent Authority.

No hard copy of the Price Bid is accepted.

- 10. In case, the specified date for the submission of bids being declared a holiday for the Client, the hard copies of the "Specified Documents" will be received up to the specified time on the next working day. However, the date and time for online submission of the bids shall continue to be the date and time specified in NIT above or any amendment for the same.
- 11. Hard copy(ies) of the "requisite documents" received by the Client after the deadline for submission of bids will be considered as late Bids even if the Bidder has uploaded the bid within the stipulated deadline. In such a case, the bids may be considered for rejection.

- **13.** The Part-II (Financial Proposal) of only those bidders will be opened subsequently, who fulfill qualification requirement (QR) and whose "QR & Techno-commercial Bid" (i.e. Part-I) is substantially responsive to the requirement of the bidding documents.
